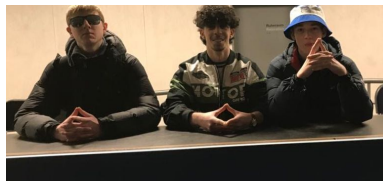


A few words from Ms Lavoile

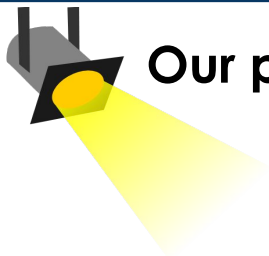

- You will also have introductions to other areas of sixth form life like the Northwood Diploma and Work Experience.



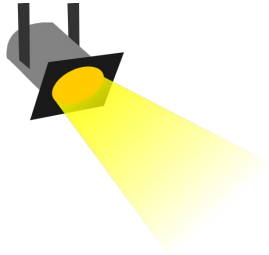

I have met such amazing individuals in sixth form, especially those who I walk home with- Abhiram

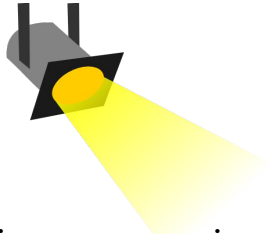

I have been so inspired by the sixth form. Northwood has given me an exceptional foundation of knowledge that I hope to expand in University- Ollie

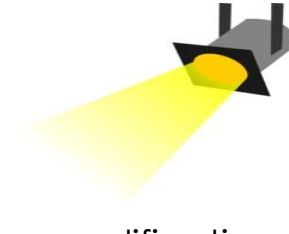



Amy S - What are wormholes and does Interstellar (2014) perpetuate common misconceptions about wormholes?

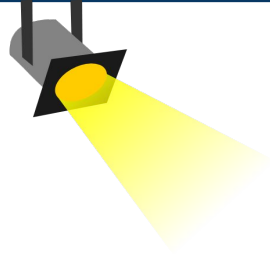
Lilly F - Was Hilary Clinton's loss of the 2016 election due to the role of the media, Trump's populist techniques or the fact she was a woman?

Amandeep - How will technological advancements impact the development of Aviation in the next twenty years?

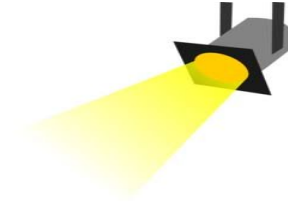
Caitlin R - Is taking performance enhancements worth it and do athletes need them to succeed?
